

ART DEPARTMENT - PRODUCTION DESIGN

The Art Department is a team of people who design, create and source all the sets and props for a production. Jobs in an art department include Designers, Art Directors, Draftsmen, Graphic Designers, Set Decorators, Art Department Assistants, Set Builders, Painters and many more. Everything in the background and props used by actors are the responsibility of the Art Department.

PRODUCTION DEPARTMENT

The Production Department is responsible for all of the admin for a show. They build the team, ensure all paperwork is issued to the correct people and send out the call sheets so everyone on the production know what is going on the following day. They play a very important part in ensuring the production runs smoothly and that everyone is working in a safe environment.

CAMERA & LIGHTING

The Camera and Lighting teams are responsible for what the shots look like on camera. The correct lighting and camera angles can make or break a film. They both work very closely with the Director of Photography to work out equipment and shooting options. There is a lot of set up in both these roles but the end results can be very rewarding.

POST-PRODUCTION

After filming is complete, all the footage goes to the Post-Production Teams. They are responsible for assembling all of the raw footage, adding colour grading, sound, music, text and generally bringing the whole film together. This process can take a while as there can be a lot of footage to go through. Some scenes may also need to go to visual effects.
